## A Letter From Your MP

Hello to you all in St Teath! With the Cornwall Council local elections just around the corner (on 1st May!), momentum is really building. We have a strong team of hardworking, community-focused Liberal Democrat candidates standing here in North Cornwall, and I truly believe we now have the opportunity to deliver the change our communities so urgently need. After years of waste, controversy, and mismanagement under the Conservatives, from the £1 million blown on the Newquay Airport sale debacle to the unchecked rise in second homes, many people I speak to know it's time for a fresh start.



In these last few weeks, I've raised a variety of important issues that affect constituents right across North Cornwall. One was the staggering fact that second homes in St Minver now make up around 44% of all housing in the village – the highest in all of Cornwall. It's a statistic that should alarm anyone who cares about the future of our communities. After speaking to residents alongside our candidate for Wadebridge East and St Minver, Rosie Moore, it was clear that local people are fed up with being priced out of their own towns and villages. That's why I'll continue pushing forward my 'AirBnB Bill'; and why we need Cornwall Council representatives who will back bold action on housing – not just make excuses.

I also raised concerns about a situation in St Eval around the privately owned community playing field. This space is a vital community asset, and the will of the Parish Council isn't seeming to be respected. I've now officially written to the company that owns the land, asking for a meeting to discuss this issue further. James O'Keefe, our Liberal Democrat candidate for the Padstow ward, has already shown how committed he is to standing up for residents, and I know he'll fight tooth and nail for action.

Turning to transport issues here in North Cornwall (a very common theme since my election), I've written to the Rail Minister to raise the serious accessibility issues at Bodmin Parkway station. I've seen with my own eyes how disabled passengers have been carried up steps and over the footbridge just to access the London-bound platform, for trains that journey to the rest of the country. It's disgraceful. We need urgent upgrades to ensure the station meets the needs of everyone, and I'll keep pushing for answers until we see a plan for action.

On the sewage crisis, things are continuing to spiral. Yet more reports highlighted how 36 Cornish beaches have had sewage dumped into them, even as water bills continue to soar. I've spoken to constituents who have even had their water bills rise in the range of 150% and more, which is completely unacceptable. I've called again for South West Water's CEO, Susan Davy, to resign over this – and I'm not backing down. Her company's repeated failings are unforgivable, and I'll keep pushing both Ofwat and DEFRA to take real action.

And finally, many of you may have seen that the Liberal Democrat Leader, Sir Ed Davey, visited our constituency, and was out supporting our excellent candidates in Bude and surrounding areas. From carer support to coastal infrastructure, this team really understands the needs of the area – and I'm looking forward to seeing what we can achieve together after 1 May.

I hope to see many of you out and about soon, but until then, do take care.

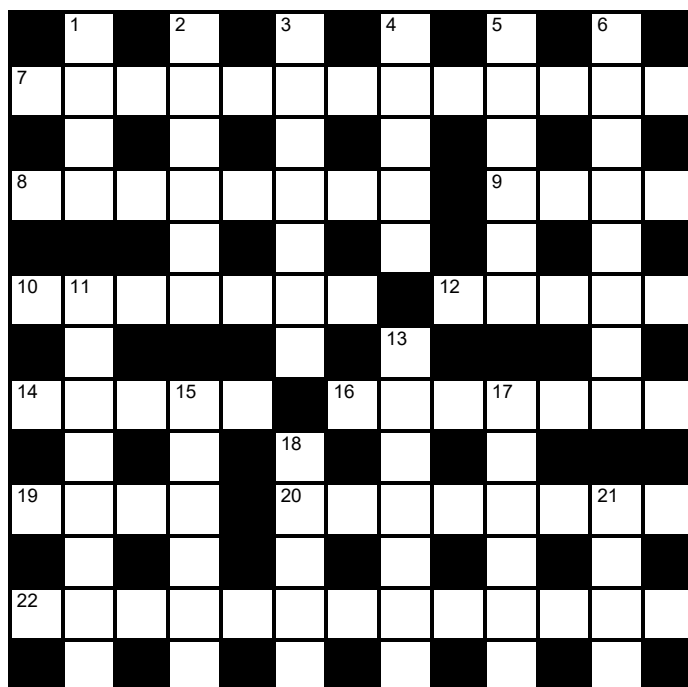

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## Revd. Jeffrey Writes...

The 8th May this year is the historic 80th anniversary of VE (Victory in Europe) Day, when the nation will celebrate 80 years since the end of the Second World War in Europe. The 15th August will be the 80th anniversary of VJ (Victory in Japan) Day, which marked the final cessation of hostilities when Japan surrendered after the dropping of the US nuclear bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki.



Although some of us may feel a little ambivalent about celebrating the dawn of the nuclear age in August, we need have no such qualms about celebrating the defeat of Hitler's Germany which, with its appallingly wicked murder of so many innocent Jewish men, women and children, among so many others, is probably the most evil regime that has ever held sway over a significant part of the globe.

The Second World War was the largest and most violent military conflict in human history. Official casualty sources estimate military deaths at nearly 15 million and civilian deaths at over 38 million. VE Day 80 is not only a celebration of the triumph over evil and the restoration of peace in Europe, but also a tribute to those who fought for the freedom we enjoy today and to those millions of non-belligerent civilians whose lives were prematurely stolen from them. It is a day of both joyful celebration and solemn remembrance. It is tragically ironic that VE Day 80 falls in the third year of the war in Ukraine, the largest military conflict in Europe since the Second World War.

At 9 am on 8th May, town criers across the nation will make the VE Day Proclamation; at 12 noon, pipers will play a new piece, "Celebratum", from the top of the UK's four highest peaks; at 6.30 pm, church bells will ring out in unified celebration of the return to peace; and at 9.30 pm, over 1,000 beacons will shine out as many will gather to sing "I Vow To Thee My Country".

Here in our Benefice, we will gather by the war memorial in the churchyard of St Julitta's at Lanteglos-by-Camelford for a brief act of Remembrance at 5.30 pm by the war memorial, when wreaths will be laid by the Royal British Legion and the Town Council. This will be followed by a special service at St Julitta's, which will conclude as the bells ring out for half an hour at 6.30 pm. The celebrations will continue by the bandstand in Camelford later in the evening, when a beacon will be lit in conjunction with those being lit across the nation.

There will also be events to mark the occasion at St Teath and Delabole. There will be a brief commemoration at the Clock Tower in St Teath at 6.10 pm, leading up to the ringing of the bells at 6.30 pm. At Delabole there is likely to be a joint service of Anglicans and Methodists earlier in the day at the War Memorial, probably at 10.45 am. Please check details of the Delabole service nearer the time.

## Speedwatch

The Speedwatch team paid its first visit to the 20 mph zone in Helstone at the end of March and recorded 40 speeders:

4 x 37, 2 x 36, 1 x 34, 1 x 32, 1 x 30, 6 x 29, 3 x 28, 7 x 27,  
4 x 26, 5 x 25, 6 x 24

In the St Teath zones, 1 person has been caught speeding 4 times, 10 have been caught 3 times and 67 caught twice.

The team also received March 2025 figures for all the Speedwatch sessions in Cornwall and Devon.

With 75 speeders, St Teath is third behind Pipers Pool (173 speeders) and Umberleigh in North Devon (85). Not a ranking to be proud of.

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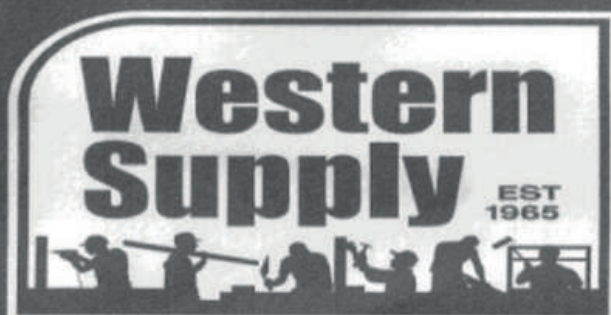
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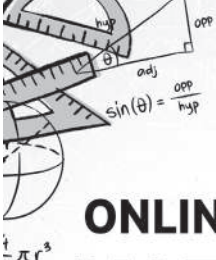
